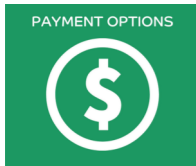

Building and Development Permits:

Are you looking to build on or renovate your property? Development and/or building permits are required for most construction projects in WHRM. If you are renovating an existing building, constructing a new building, or putting up a storage shed, you need to obtain a permit before starting the job - even when under 100 sq. ft.

Permits are also needed for small projects such as signs, awnings, decks, porches, swimming pools, fences, and garden sheds and for repairs, alterations, additions, or demolition of existing buildings.

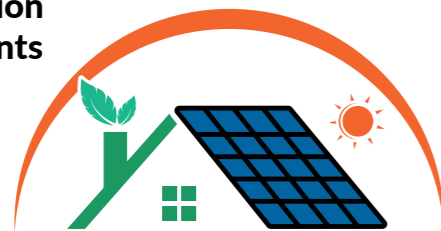
Please note that the issuance of a permit can take between 4-6 weeks from the time all required application material has been received by staff.

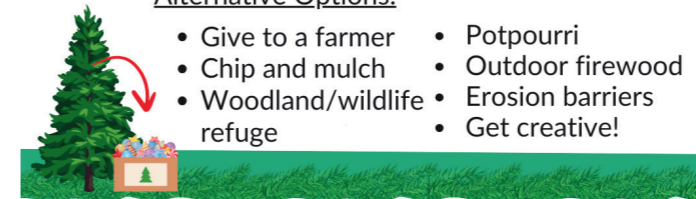
Christmas Tree: Curbside Collection

IMPORTANT NOTE: Ensure ALL ornaments, lights, tinsel and garland is removed before donating, upcycling or disposing of your tree.

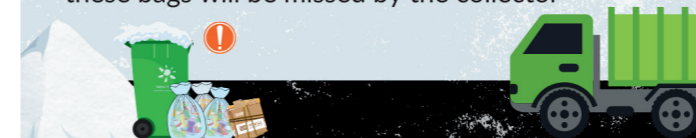
Alternative Options:

Green Bin: Winter Tips

- Snowbanks can obstruct the collector's view of your waste, ensure there is a clear pathway
- Place waste where collectors can see it from the direction they are approaching from
- Keep lid closed when not in use
- Remove snow and ice from bin
- DO NOT place recycling bags in your green bin these bags will be missed by the collector



Are You Hosting an Event in 2025?

A Special Event Permit maybe required if hosting a large event in West Hants, on private or public property. Likewise, a parade, procession or a walkathon, on a WHRM Street or provincial roadway, requires a Street Event application be submitted to the Municipal Traffic Authority or to NS Department of Public Works.

Winter Operations & Snow Removal



While West Hants Regional Municipality does not have a winter parking ban, we enforce the following provincial Acts that you should be aware of:

WINTER BYLAW INFRACTIONS:

Section 139 of the Motor Vehicle Act states: No person shall willfully park or leave standing a vehicle, attended or unattended, on a street or part thereof which interferes or obstructs snow removal during or after a snow storm, or in any way obstructs winter maintenance, i.e. salting. Vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense.

Section 318 of the Municipal Government Act states: Snow is not to be moved across any streets or placed onto any street or public sidewalks. Snow shall be stored on the property being cleared or hauled away and dumped in an approved location.
