



TOWN OF WINDSOR BYLAW # 27 SKATEBOARDING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Windsor, pursuant to the provisions of Section 153N of the Towns Act, enacts the following bylaw:

Section 1

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this Bylaw:

- (a) "Sidewalk" means any public path, lane, walkway, or other area designed for pedestrian travel or use.
- (b) "Skateboard" means a board constructed of any material which has affixed thereto rollers or wheels designed to be mounted or operated by an individual or individuals.
- (c) "Town" means the Town of Windsor.

Section 2

PROHIBITIONS


No person shall use or operate a skateboard on any sidewalk in the Town of Windsor.

Section 3

PENALTY

Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offence, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding seven days.
