**BYLAW # 47**  
**REPEAL OF BYLAW #43 – ELECTRONIC VOTING BYLAW**

**AUTHORITY**

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act (MGA), Section 146A(1) states that a Council may by by-law authorize voters to vote by mail, electronically or by any other voting method.

Local government bylaws may only be amended or repealed by by-law. Amendment and repeal by-laws are subject to the same requirements as the legislative authority to establish a new one. The adoption procedures outlined in Part VII, By-Laws, Sections 168 and 169 apply to all by-laws including a repeal by-law.

**TITLE**

This By-law is entitled the “Repeal of Bylaw #43 – Electronic Voting Bylaw.”

**PURPOSE**

Bylaw #47 hereby repeals Bylaw #43 – Electronic Voting Bylaw.
