**REPEAL OF BYLAW #05 – ELECTIONS, PLEBISCITES AND PUBLIC MEETINGS**  
**BYLAW**

**AUTHORITY**

Pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act, R.S.N.S., 1989, Chapter 300, (with Amendments to April 15, 2016), states that “every nomination paper shall be accompanied by a deposit of two hundred dollars, provided that the council may by by-law specify that a lesser deposit, or no deposit, shall be required.”

Local government bylaws may only be amended or repealed by by-law. Amendment and repeal by-laws are subject to the same requirements as the legislative authority to establish a new one. The adoption procedures outlined in Part VII, By-Laws, Sections 168 and 169 apply to all by-laws including a repeal by-law.

**TITLE**

This By-law is entitled the “Repeal of Bylaw #05 – Elections, Plebiscites and Public Meetings Bylaw.”


**PURPOSE**

Bylaw #48 hereby repeals Bylaw #05 – Elections, Plebiscites and Public Meetings Bylaw.
