REPEAL OF BYLAW #04 – CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER BYLAW

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act (MGA), Part II, Sections 28, 29, 30, 31, and 32 outline that *council may appoint a Chief Administrative Officer; when no Chief Administrative Officer is appointed; the Council and Chief Administrative Officer relationship; Responsibilities of the Chief Administrative Officer; and Reporting and accountability requirements.*

Local government bylaws may only be amended or repealed by by-law. Amendment and repeal by-laws are subject to the same requirements as the legislative authority to establish a new one. The adoption procedures outlined in Part VII, By-Laws, Sections 168 and 169 apply to all by-laws including a repeal by-law.

TITLE - This By-law is entitled the “Repeal of Bylaw #04 – Chief Administrative Officer Bylaw.”

PURPOSE - Bylaw #52 hereby repeals Bylaw #04 – Chief Administrative Officer Bylaw.

EFFECTIVE DATE - This bylaw is effective upon advertisement of Passage of Bylaw (publication).
