BYLAW # 55
REPEAL OF BYLAW #21 – FIRE DEPARTMENT BYLAW

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act (MGA),
Section 293, A municipality may maintain and provide fire and emergency services by providing the service, assisting others to provide the service, working with others to provide the service or a combination of means.

Section 296 (1) The council may make policies respecting full-time, volunteer and composite fire departments and emergency service providers in the municipality.

(2) Policies for fire departments and emergency service providers may include

- (a) requirements and procedures for registration;
- (b) personnel policies with respect to those members who are employees of the municipality;
- (c) the manner of accounting to the council for the use of funds provided by the municipality.

Local government bylaws may only be amended or repealed by by-law. Amendment and repeal by-laws are subject to the same requirements as the legislative authority to establish a new one. The adoption procedures outlined in Part VII, By-Laws, Sections 168 and 169 apply to all by-laws including a repeal by-law.

TITLE - This By-law is entitled the “Repeal of Bylaw #21 – Fire Department Bylaw.”

PURPOSE - Bylaw #55 hereby repeals Bylaw #21 – Fire Department Bylaw.

EFFECTIVE DATE - This bylaw is effective upon advertisement of Passage of Bylaw (publication).
