



West Hants Community Development Public Swimming at King's-Edgehill Pool

Admission Policy

NOTE: Only the first 60 people will be admitted due to capacity limits.

Swimming is a risky activity; safety is a shared responsibility.

- Children 9 to 11 years old must be actively supervised by an adult (15 years and up) on the pool deck - a **GREEN** Bracelet helps to identify these children.
- Children 8 and under must always have an adult in the water within arms reach - a **PINK** bracelet helps to identify these children.
 - 1 adult for every 3 children under 6 years old.
 - 1 adult for every 6 children aged 6-11 years old.

Facility Rules

- No outdoor footwear is permitted beyond the front desk area.
- Pool bags are permitted on the pool deck.
- Children in diapers must wear swim diapers in the pool.
- No smoking (King's-Edgehill is a smoke free campus).
- No photos or videos in pool or changeroom area.
- Do not swim if you have open cuts/sores, flu or cold symptoms or diarrhea.
- No glass or glass containers on the pool deck.
- No animals (EXCEPT service animals).
- Swearing, profanity, distasteful/discriminatory language and/or violence of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Use of alcohol and drugs (including cannabis) are strictly prohibited on KES property. Anyone who is thought to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be denied access.

KES Pool Rules:

- Walking on the pool deck only, no running.
- No diving permitted due to depth of pool.
- Diving blocks are for swim team use only.
- Inflatable objects, sinking toys, and full-face masks with snorkels are not permitted.
- Face-mask goggles with nose piece can be used at swimmer's own risk.
- No snorkels, flippers, or fins during public swim.
- Mermaid tails, or mono-fins are not permitted.
- Hypoxic Training (breath holding) is not permitted.
- No food, drinks or gum in the pool. Water in unbreakable containers is permitted.

All rules are subject to change and decisions may be made case to case bases under the discretion of lifeguards. Aquatic and KES Staff are permitted to refuse entry to any members of the public if deemed necessary. Staff have the right to ask members of the public to leave a swim if deemed necessary.
